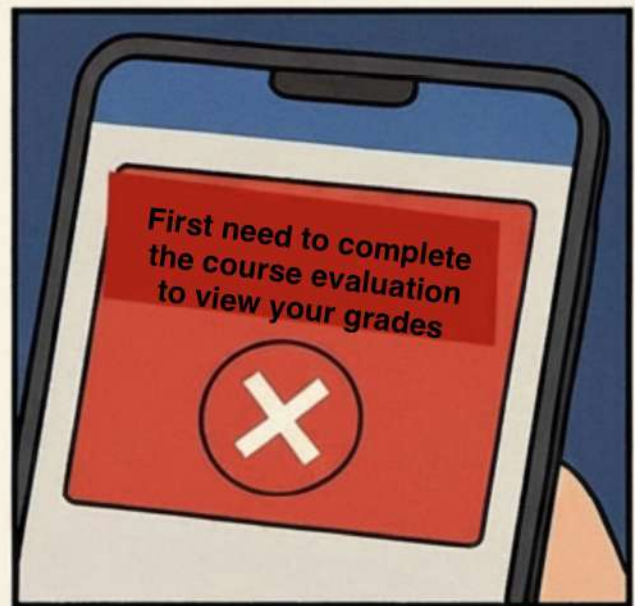
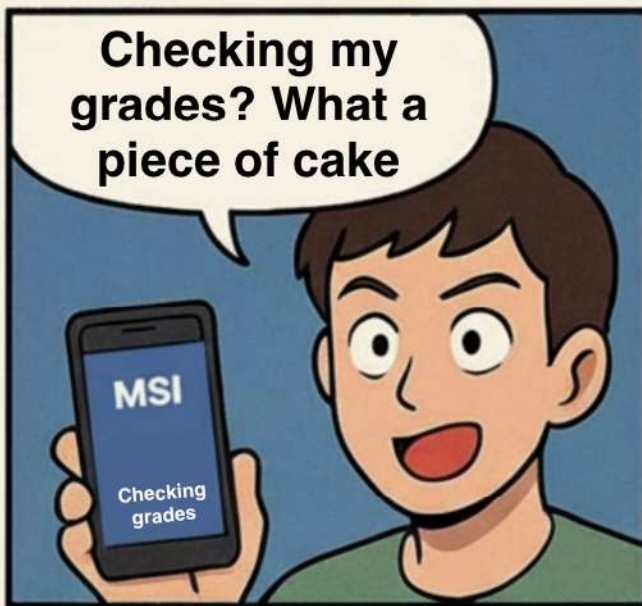

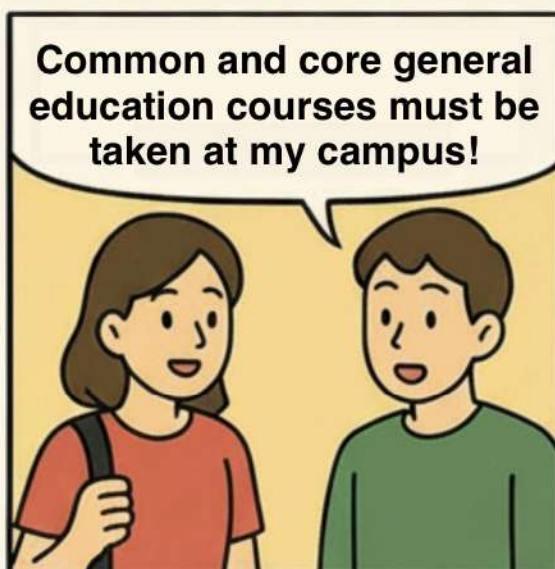

Huh? Does that mean the remaining 1 credit just disappears?



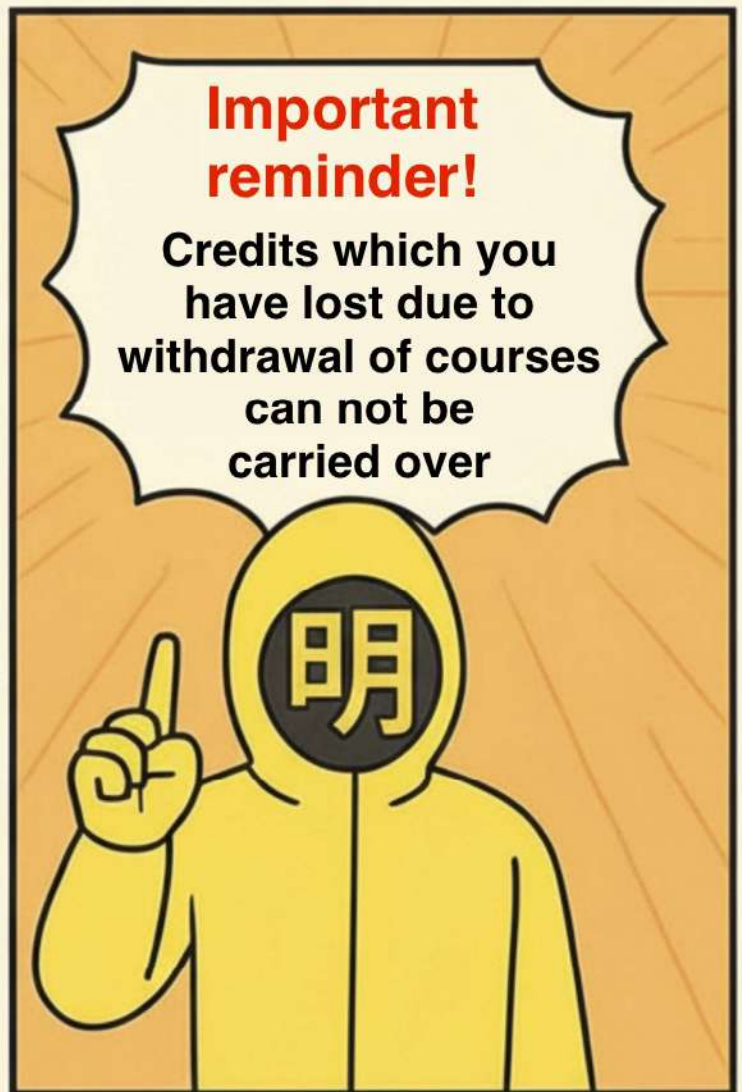
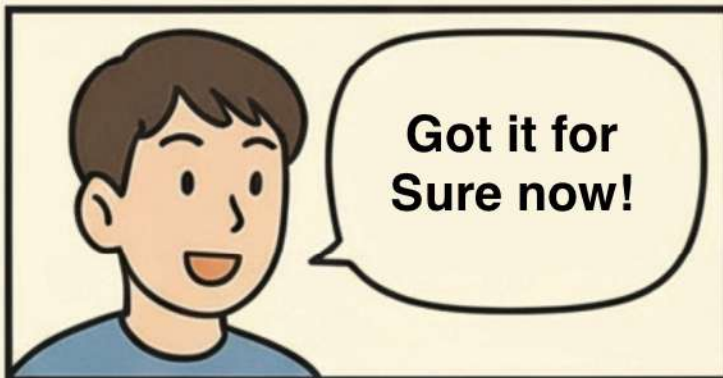
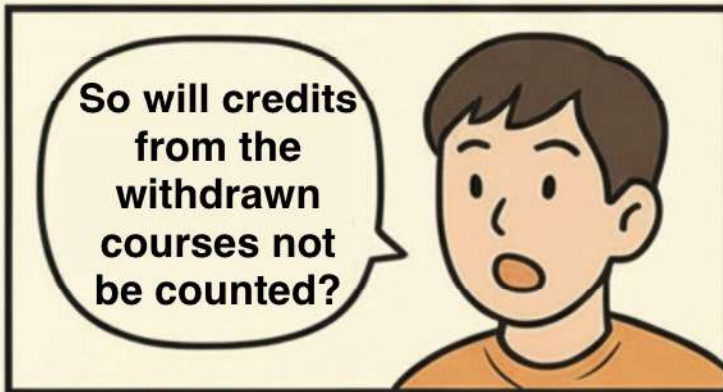
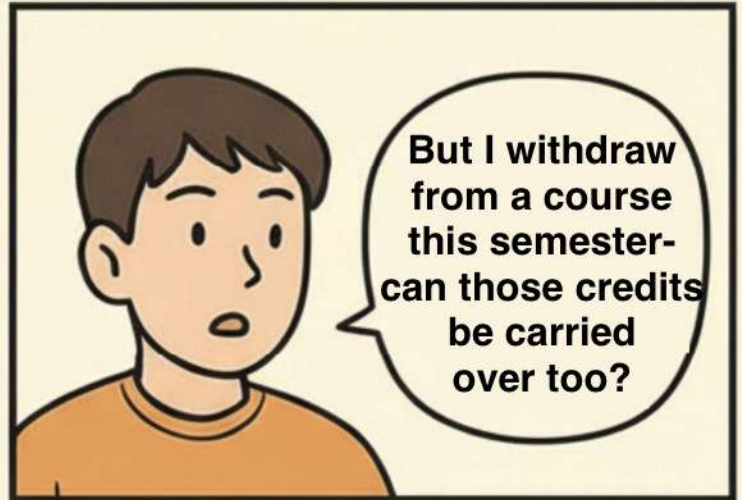
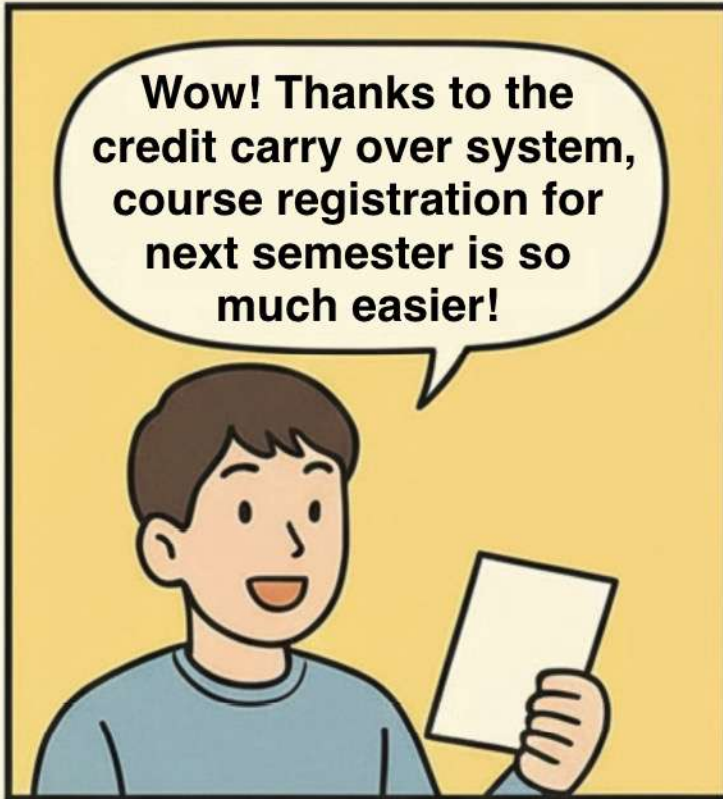
Then until when can I use my carried-over credits?

No! Credits earned from major(core) courses will only remain as major(core) credits even if you do not need them

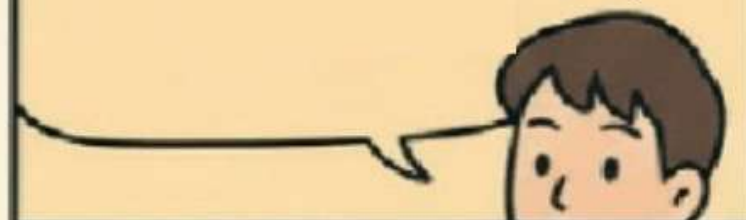


Course Eligible as General Elective Courses
